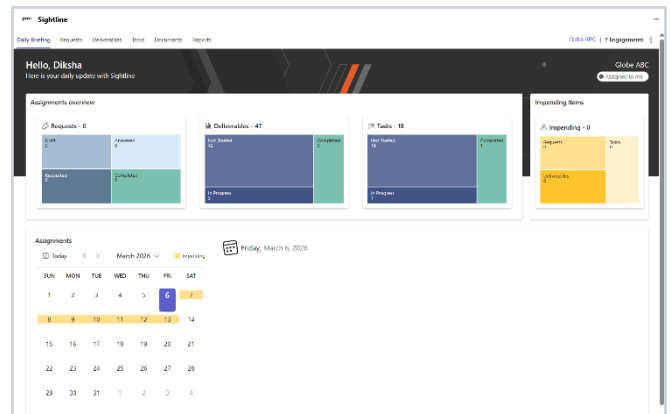
Sightline for Teams is a companion to the PwC Sightline web experience. We will meet you where you work.

Documents. View, upload and download files to collaborate with PwC and create new documents and folders to be securely stored.



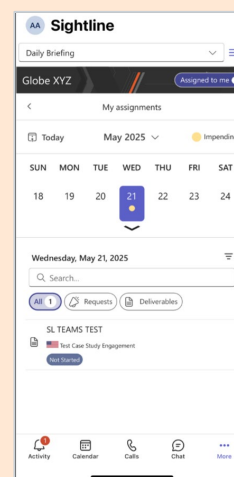
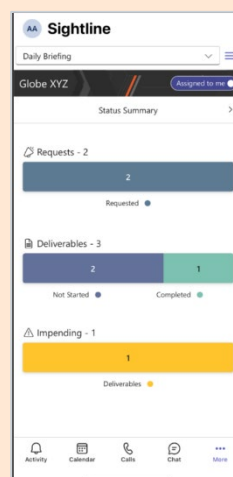
Reports. Securely explore, consume and share reports.

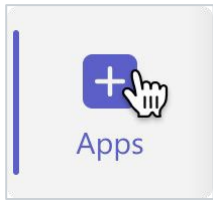

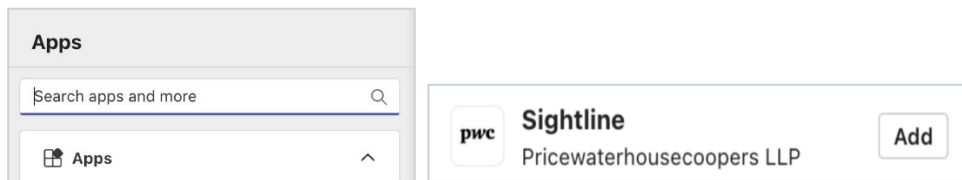
Installation steps for Sightline for Teams

Step 1: Open Microsoft Teams and click on the "Apps" icon. If you do not see the app in your Teams application, you can also find it on [Microsoft AppSource](#).

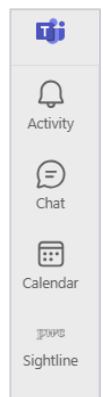
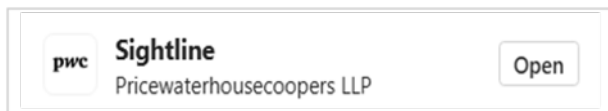

Step 2: Search for "Sightline" to locate the Sightline application widget and click "Add".



Step 3: Once it is installed, click "Open" and input your credentials (if prompted). Next you will be prompted to authenticate the account. Once this step is complete, the Sightline application will be available for use in Microsoft Teams.



After completing the installation steps for Microsoft Teams, simply click on the Sightline icon (you can also "pin" the icon). This will open the "Home" screen, and you will be taken to a landing page that gives you an overview of your engagements. Along the top of the screen, there is a horizontal menu where you can select which tool you would like to access in Sightline for Microsoft Teams.

By using Sightline for Microsoft Teams, you can work in the same way as you would with the Sightline web experience. From any page inside Sightline for Microsoft Teams, you can click on the horizontal ellipse on the top right-hand side and from the dropdown access the globe icon for Sightline Web.
